N.S.SHEKHAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the name of Gurmeet Singh, respondent No. 8 may be deleted from the array of parties and the liberty may be granted to the petitioner to avail his alternative remedies against the respondent No. 8 before the Civil Court, in accordance with law.
2. In the present case, the petitioner has confined his prayer only to the extent of issuing directions to respondents No. 5 to 7 not to interfere in the peaceful possession of the agricultural land, which was allegedly possessed and cultivated by the petitioner. He further contends that with regard to the other reliefs, he has already approached the Civil Court and he shall pursue his remedies before the Civil Court for rest of prayers.
3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of Court, Mr. I.P.S. Sabharwal, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 7.
5. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Davinder Singh submits that respondents no. 5 to 7 have no concern with the land, which is owned by the petitioner or by respondent No. 8. He further submits that respondents No.5 to 7 will not visit the land in question to interfere with the possession/ownership of either of the parties.
6. In view of the above, no further directions are required by this Court. However, it is clarified that in case any information is received with regard to the commission of cognizable offence, the police shall be at liberty to proceed in the matter, in accordance with law. Apart from that, the Civil Court shall also decide the dispute between the petitioner and respondent No. 8, without getting influenced from the observations made in the present order.
