1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 06.12.2023 passed in CWP-23688-2022.
2. Affidavit of Vivek Dhasmana, Under Secretary to the Govt. of India, Ministry of Women and Child Development, on behalf of respondent No.4, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Compliance affidavit of Deepika Saini, District Programme Officer, Women and Child Development Department, Rohtak, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
4. Counsel for the respondents have submitted that the order dated 06.12.2023 passed in CWP-23688-2022 has since been complied with and necessary payment has been made to the petitioners vide demand

draft Nos.787595 to 787597 dated 02.07.2024, respectively. The aforesaid demand drafts in original, produced by the State counsel in the Court today, have been handed over to the counsel for the petitioners. However, a copy thereof has been taken on record. 5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left unredressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
