1. Status report by way of affidavit of Ravinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Tapa, District Barnala, on behalf of respondent No.1 filed. The same is taken on record.
2. Orders dated 17.05.2018 passed in CRM-M No. 25229 of 2017 and CRM-M No.21229 of 2018 dated 11.07.2019 have been placed on record along with the said status report. Perusal of the aforesaid two orders reveals that in CRM-M No. 25229 of 2017, the impugned FIR already stands quashed qua accused namely Balvir Singh, Harpal Singh and Jaspal Singh (Petitioner No.2 in the present petition). Likewise, qua petitioner No.1 in the present petition i.e. Anil Bharti also an impugned FIR stands quashed in CRM-M No.21229 of 2018 vide order dated 11.07.2019.
3. In view of the above, since the FIR qua present petitioners already stands quashed on the basis of compromise, no further order is required to be passed.
