1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 12.01.2024 passed in CWP-730-2024.

Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 12.01.2024 passed in CWP-730-2024 has since been complied with and speaking order dated 05.04.2024 has been passed whereby claim of the petitioner has been rejected.
