1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 12.01.2024 passed in CWP-715-2024.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of the respondent, filed in the Registry, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 12.01.2024 passed in CWP-715-202 has since been complied with and speaking order dated 05.04.2024 (Annexure R-1) has been passed whereby claim of the petitioner has been rejected.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if he feels aggrieved of the order dated 05.04.2024 (Annexure R-1) passed by the respondent/concerned authority.
