1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 10.01.2024 passed in CWP-17964-2018.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 10.01.2024 passed in CWP-17964-2018 has since been complied with and necessary benefits have been granted to the petitioner.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
