



3. Meanwhile, the records reveal that the land was acquired for establishment of an industrial focal point and certain compensation, as mentioned in the reply of the State, was released in favour of the Gram Panchayat.
4. The land in dispute is already vested in the Government pursuant to the acquisition. Hence, the petitioners always have a remedy of approaching the Civil Court.
5. With the aforesaid liberty and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition stands disposed of.
