1. Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks leave to withdraw the writ petition.
2. Leave granted.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, the respondent-State may, in terms of relevant policies, consider the making of allotments to the present petitioners, of such allotable lands, which are not the subject lands. An application in the above regard is directed to be forthwith preferred, before the Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat concerned, and thereafter the Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat concerned, may consider to pass a Panchayat resolution to

the said effect, and if such a Panchayat resolution is passed, thereupon, the competent approving authority may consider the making of allotments of allotable lands to the present petitioner, which are other than the subject lands.
