The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of certiorari quashing the order dated 19.05.2001, Annexure P-6, passed by the third respondent terminating the petitioner's service.

2. As per written statement filed on behalf of respondent nos. 2 & 3, the second respondent/Guru Nanak Senior Secondary School, Kurukshetra, is an un-aided minority institution and the petitioner was working as a part-time Lecturer on an un-sanctioned post. His service was terminated, vide the impugned order dated 19.05.2001, on the ground that the post had been abolished as there were no students in the subject of Political Science. He was accordingly relieved from duty with effect from 19.05.2001, giving one month salary in lieu of notice period in terms of the conditions of the appointment.

3. There is no denial to these facts, nor has any counter affidavit been filed by the petitioner. Therefore, no exception can be taken to the order of termination. Besides, the petition has been filed against the private un-aided institution, which renders it not maintainable.
4. Finding no merit in the petition, it stands dismissed.
5. Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
