- 1. Exemption, as prayed for, is granted.
- 2. Application is allowed.

Main case

- 1. By way of instant criminal revision petition filed under Section 401, Cr.P.C., petitioner has approached this Court for setting aside the order dated 11.04.2023 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar and order dated 21.11.2022 passed by the learned Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Amritsar, vide his regular bail application filed under Section 12 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 (for short “the Act”), has been dismissed.
- 2. Previous petition, filed by the petitioner, was withdrawn from this Court by order dated 20.11.2023. Except for a custody of a little over four months, no fresh ground has been made out for grant of bail to the petitioner.
- 3. Petition is dismissed.
- 4. Needless to mention, it is always open to the petitioner to approach the Court concerned again with a fresh petition for bail under the provisions of the Act.
- 5. Pending applications stands disposed of.
