Prayer in this writ petition filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the Public Notice dated 19.02.2024 (Annexure P-7) issued by respondent No.3, vide which the case of the petitioners for their appointment as Driver/Operator/Firemen has been rejected and they have been shown as not eligible without their being any valid and justified reason. Further a writ of mandamus has been sought for directing the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners for their appointment as a Driver/Operator as they have already been shown as eligible for their appointment in the Revised Final Result of Physical Measurement and Efficiency Test for the post of Driver/Operator and Firemen dated 18.10.2023 to 23.10.2023 (Annexure P-6). Further ad interim direction be issued to the respondents to reserve the post vacant for the candidature of the petitioners till the final outcome of the present petition.

After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petition may be disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to approach the concerned authorities for redressal of their grievances by submitting a justice demand notice.

Disposed of with aforesaid liberty.

If any such, justice demand notice is served by the petitioners within a period of 01 week from today, the same shall be considered by the competent authority within a period of 01 month thereafter.
