1. The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case bearing FIR No.217 dated 20.09.2023 under Sections 21, 22/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur.
2. Learned State counsel, at the outset, submits that the petitioner is accused of having in his conscious possession contraband falling in the commercial quantity; he is involved in three more cases unde NDPS Act registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur and the investigating agency has presented the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. today itself i.e. 20.03.2024. As such, the petitioner is not entitled to regular bail in view of

embargo put under Section 36 of NDPS Act.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
