The petitioner, by way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeks grant of regular bail pending trial in case bearing FIR No.58 dated 07.11.2023, under Sections 307 / 341 / 323 / 324 / 148 / 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur, wherein he has been implicated of having given injury upon the person of Ram Asra.

[2] Learned State Counsel vehemently opposes the prayer for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, while submitting that the allegations were levelled in the FIR wherein the injuries were inflicted with *iron rod*.

[3] I have heard learned counsel for the parties and gone through the paper-book. I find substance in the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner.
