1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 10.01.2023 passed in CRM-M-50873-2022.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Gunjan Mehta, Addl. A. G. Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.
4. Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from ASI Angrej Singh, submits that the order dated 10.01.2023 passed in CRM-M-50873-2022 has since been complied with. An inquiry was conducted into the matter and the complaint of the petitioner was closed, vide order dated 30.06.2023. The inquiry report filed by the counsel for the respondent in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unaddressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
