1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 19.10.2023 passed in CRM-M-46089-2023.

3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 19.10.2023 passed in CRM-M-46089-2023 has been complied with and decision qua the claim of the petitioner has already been taken.
