1. In the present petition, grievance of the petitioner is that the employees junior to him have been promoted to the post of Kanungo without considering the claim of the petitioner and hence, either the promotion order of respondent No.4 be set aside or petitioner be also given benefit of promotion to the post of Kanungo from the date person junior to him has been promoted with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner by way of submitting the representation dated 20.10.2023 (Annexure P-4) and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of

the State.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case representation dated 20.10.2023 (Annexure P-4) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 04 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioner, the same will be extended to him otherwise, due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.

8. It may be noticed that in case, respondents do not comply with their undertaking as recorded hereinbefore, a strict view will be taken including initiation of contempt proceedings.
