This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 to 4 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No. 5 and 6 for committing fraud and cheating with the petitioner by misusing the cheques taken from the petitioner on the pretext of sanction of loan and further usurping four tolas of gold of the petitioner by making inducement to grant loan to the tune of Rs. 90 lacs on the basis of forged and fabricated pre sanction letter.

2. Reply by way of an affidavit dated 07.12.2024 of Sh. Sarwan Singh Bal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Phillaur, District Jalandhar (Rural) has been filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record.

In the status report, the following has been stated :-



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complaint, notice (parvanas) were sent to the petitioner on 07.02.2021, 04.03.2021, 10.03.2021 and 21.04.2021 to get his statement recorded and produce documents/evidence. However, despite the fact that four notices (parvanas) were sent to petitioner, neither the petitioner responded to the said notices nor did he come present at police station.

5. Thus, the complaint given by the petitioner was closed on 27.04.2021 as the petitioner did not get his statement recorded or produce any document/evidence to prove his allegations.”

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to file fresh representation in accordance with law.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforementioned liberty.
