HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that a stigmatic order has been passed by the respondents qua the earlier period of service which the petitioner had rendered, while not extending the tenure of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the said order was passed but subsequently once again, the petitioner has been appointed at Ambala to perform the duties but probably, due to the said impugned stigmatic order, he has not been given extension on the post of Medical Officer in Panchkula hence, the impugned order is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that upon re-consideration of all the facts and circumstances of the present case, the authorities have decided to give another opportunity to the petitioner to work for the State and he has been given extension in service so as to continue to work at Ambala for a period of three months upto 31.07.2024, and in case, the work and conduct of the petitioner remains good, he will be allowed to discharge the duties further by giving extension in service as being given to the other similarly situated doctors who are working on the same post on same terms and conditions.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further, at this stage.

7. Ordered accordingly.
