This is a contempt petition filed under Section 10 read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 13.12.2021 passed in Civil Revision No.1861-2021.

Perusal of the file shows that the order qua which the contempt is alleged is of the nature, for determination of contempt for which a lot of disputed questions would be required to be adjudicated upon. However, adjudication of disputed questions of fact would not even be appropriate in the contempt petition. Hence, the present petition is dismissed.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
