HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioner is that some of the juniors of the petitioners have been granted higher pay scale who are also working in the same project i.e. ICPS Scheme whereas, the petitioner is being granted lesser pay scale despite being senior to them, which is not permissible.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents be directed to promote the petitioner to the post of Accountant and grant the regular pay scale from the date the juniors have been granted the said benefit.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 04.08.2022 (Annexure P-12) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be

satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the representation dated 04.08.2022 (Annexure P-12) has been received in the office of concerned authorities, the same will be decided by the authorities concerned within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
