This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 15.07.2011 passed by this Court in RSA-5950-2003.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3 has submitted that as on the date of passing of the status quo order, respondent No.2-Rattan Lal was recorded as owner in the municipal record. Thereafter, on some application moved by the parties, the entries were changed in the year 2015. However, after coming to know about the status quo order, the said entries have been changed and the status quo has been restored by the Municipal Corporation, Yamuna Nagar, Jagadhri. Specific letter dated 04.10.2021 (Annexure R-7) in this regard has also been sent to the respective parties.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to proceed further in the matter.

Dismissed.
