The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the complaint case no.NACT 2995 of 2023 dated 12.07.22023 (Annexure P-1) titled as Kashmir Singh Thind Vs. Ashwani Sharma etc. filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act wherein the petitioner has been summoned under Section 138 of the NI Act.

On 19.03.2024 the following order was passed:-

“ *In the interest of justice, adjourned to 30.07.22024.*

It is made clear that pendency of this petition shall not be construed as a stay of the proceedings before the Trial Court which is free to proceed with the matter in accordance with law.”

On 30.07.2024 the following order was passed:-

“ *The learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the*



petitioner shall put in appearance before the Trial Court on the next date of hearing.

List again on 21.08.2024.”

On 21.08.2024 the following order was passed:-

“ *The learned Counsel for the petitioner seeks time to place on record the order showing that the petitioner has surrendered before the Trial Court.*

Adjourned to 23.08.2024.”

Apparently, the petitioner is playing hide and seek with the Court, therefore, the present petition stands dismissed for want of prosecution.
