1. The petitioner is seeking setting aside of order dated 09.02.2024 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge-I, Kapurthala vide which her bail/surety bonds were cancelled and non-bailable warrants of arrest were issued against her in case FIR No.160 dated 30.06.2019 under Section 306 of the IPC registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that the petitioner is willing and ready to appear, and surrender before the Trial Court. Hence, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner be protected till her appearance before the Trial Court and with directions to the Trial Court that her bail application, which she would be filing on her surrender, be decided expeditiously.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Amit Rana, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to

the petitioner to appear and surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner. This shall, however, subject to deposit of Rs.10,000/- as costs with the Trustee committee of Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana Account No.65271098399 IFSC SBIN0050719, State Bank of India, Branch District Court, Sector-43, Chandigarh.

6. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today, this order shall be of no avail to her, thereafter. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for bail before the Trial Court, the same shall be decided by the Trial Court in accordance with law.
