The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for quashing the order dated 31.10.2002 (Annexure P-5) passed by Respondent No.1, order dated 02.05.1997 passed by Respondent No.2, who had set aside the award dated 18.09.1996 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Arbitrator - Respondent Nos.6.

Learned State counsel on instructions from the respondents submits that Respondent No.3- Mr. Balor Singh owed Medium term Loan of Rs.7,537/- being principal amount and Rs.663/- as interest amount and Rs.250/- as expenses, which in total comes to Rs.8,450/- to Respondent No.4- the Dod Cooperative Agricultural Service Society Ltd. Dod and the dispute arose regarding repayment of said amount to the society.

Learned State counsel submits that the amount in question alongwith upto date interest accrued thereupon till 22.07.2021 i.e. Rs.47,000/-, has duly been deposited by Respondent No.3 with the Society and, therefore, nothing survives in the present petition. The receipt and certificate issued by the Society in this regard has been produced and the same is taken on record.

In this view of the matter, the present petition has become infructuous.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

All pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
