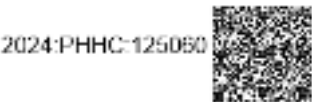

Present third petition has been filed under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in FIR No. 119 dated 13.03.2018 under Sections 120-B, 109, 216, 307, 302 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Badshahpur, District Gurugram.

(2) When this Court was not inclined to accept the prayer, learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner does not press the present petition at this stage. However, he submits that keeping in view the custody of petitioner, learned trial Court be directed to conclude the proceedings in a time bound manner.

(3) Although this Court is not issuing any mandate to learned trial Court but, in view of the long custody of petitioner, learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram is requested to make all possible legal efforts for securing the presence of prosecution witnesses.



- (4) Commissioner of Police, Gurugram and Superintendent of District Jail, Bhondsi, Gurugram are directed to fully cooperate in the matter.
- (5) Disposed off with the above observations.
- (6) It is clarified that this order be not construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the case in any manner.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
