1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 read with Section 2-A of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 08.12.2023 passed in CWP-27593-2023.
2. Counsel for the respondent has submitted that the order dated 08.12.2023 passed in CWP-27593-2023 has since been complied with and legal notice of the petitioner has been decided. The payment to which the petitioner was found to be entitled, has already been released in her favour. Copy of letter dated 21.05.2024 to that effect has also been placed on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
4. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
