1. The present revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for modification of the order dated 23.01.2024 passed by the Ld. Family Court, Patiala (P-17) to the extent that divorce petition bearing CIS No.DMC/1515/2020 titled as “Nitin Kumar Vs. Isha Malhotra” be decided as per the mandate of Section 21-B of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner would be satisfied if directions are issued to the Ld. Family Court to decide the divorce case filed by the petitioner in a time bound manner.
3. Without commenting upon the merits of the case and in the interest of justice, the concerned Family Court is directed to decide the divorce case filed by the petitioner expeditiously. It be ensured that no unnecessary adjournment is given to any of the parties.
