1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 08.08.2022 passed in CWP-17399-2022.
2. Compliance report dated 21.11.2023 by way of affidavit of T.V.S.N. Prasad, Additional Chief Secretary to Government Haryana, Home Department, Haryana, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent has submitted that pursuant to the order dated 08.08.2022 passed in CWP-17399-2022, claim of the petitioner has been considered and the speaking order dated 16.11.2023 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
6. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if he feels aggrieved of the order passed by the respondent.
