The appellants have filed the present appeal under Section 14-A of the Schedule Castes and Schedule Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (hereinafter to be referred as 'the SC and ST Act') before this Court to challenge the impugned order dated 06.03.2024 passed by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Bhiwani, whereby, the anticipatory bail petition in Case FIR No. 627 dated 16.12.2023 registered under Sections 323, 341 and 34 of the IPC (Section 342 of IPC added later on) and Section 3(2)(va) of the SC and ST Act (added later on) filed by the appellants was ordered to be dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the appellants submits that in compliance of the order dated 18.03.2024 passed by this Court, the appellants have joined the investigation.
3. As per office report, dasti process issued for the service of respondent No.2 has been received by the wife of respondent No.2. Learned State counsel also submits that the concerned SHO has informed respondent No.2 in writing with regard to the pendency of the present appeal before this Court. Still neither respondent No.2 has appeared in person nor represented by his counsel. Learned State counsel has submitted that the appellants have joined the investigation and are no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present appeal is allowed and the interim order dated 18.03.2024, passed by this Court is made absolute. The appellants shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
