The instant writ petition has been filed for seeking a direction to the respondents to release the payment of Rs.2,06,311/- for carrying out the work of sprinkling medicine on garbage in Meghpur Dumping Point with the help of tractor trolley and labour along with interest @ 18% per annum.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.4-Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Palwal, to decide

the legal notice dated 12.05.2023 (Annexure P-10) sent by the petitioner by passing a speaking and reasoned order in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Pankaj Mulwani, Deputy A.G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 whereas Mr.Vivek Saini, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.3 and 4 and they have no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4- Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Palwal, to decide the legal notice dated 12.05.2023 (Annexure P-10) sent by the petitioner and to pass a speaking and reasoned order thereupon in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

Needless to mention that in the event the entitlement of the petitioner being established as per law, the payment due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously and preferably within a further period of three months.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
