Main case

Prayer made in the present writ petition was for seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.5 and 6 to allow the petitioner to

cast his vote in the election of Barnala Circle conducted for the post of President, Vice President and General Secretary which was scheduled to be held on 17.03.2024 as the petitioner was not being permitted to cast the same.

Vide order dated 15.03.2024, the petitioner was permitted to provisionally cast his vote in the elections of the Police Pensioners Welfare Association, Barnala Circle, Punjab.

Learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 7 contends that the petitioner was permitted to cast his vote and the elections have already been held, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

A written request for an adjournment has been circulated on behalf of the learned counsel for the petitioner. However, taking into consideration the facts of the present case, I am of the opinion that no purpose would be served by keeping the present writ petition pending. Hence, while keeping the questions with respect to the eligibility of the petitioner, if any, open, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous at this stage since the prayer of the petitioner was limited and the same has already been redressed.
