Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.0176 dated 28.09.2023 registered under Sections 22, 29 of (Act No.61 of 1985) of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur.

As per prosecution allegations, 13 intoxicating injections without any label were recovered from the possession of the petitioner on 28.09.2023. She was apprehended. Vide order dated 06.11.2023 (Annexure P-2) petitioner was granted interim bail till receipt of the chemical report with the condition that she shall surrender before the Court, in case the FSL report reveals that contraband falls in the commercial category.

After receipt of the FSL report indicating that recovery quantity fell in the commercial category, petitioner did not surrender and rather has approached this Court by way of present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for anticipatory bail.

Petitioner is hereby directed to make compliance of the order dated 06.11.2023 passed by learned Special Court, Hoshiarpur, as conditional bail was granted to her on her undertaking that she shall surrender in case FSL report shows that contraband fell in the commercial category.

No ground for anticipatory bail is made out.
