1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 115 and 151 CPC for setting aside the impugned order dated 24.08.2021 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Divn.), Faridabad vide which the review application filed by the petitioner has been dismissed.
2. It has been brought to the notice of this Court that the main case itself has been decided vide order dated 26.02.2024 by the Civil Judge (Junior Divn.), Faridabad and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
