Present revision petition has been filed against the judgment dated 05.10.2021 passed in maintenance case No. 267 of 2017 titled as *Anuradha Vs. Navdeep* by learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Karnal vide which petitioner has been directed to pay maintenance to the tune of Rs. 10,000/- per month to the respondent.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that present petition has been rendered infructuous as pursuant to the mediation between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, a joint petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act was filed by the petitioner and respondent and a decree of divorce has already been passed by way of mutual consent and all the disputes with regard to past, present and future alimony have been settled.
