1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to temporarily allot the vacant government building constructed for educational purpose to the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that a school building in village Chilawli, District Nuh, had been constructed after spending Rs.16.80 crores by a government building construction company (NBBC) hired by Mewat Development Agency and the said building is lying vacant since more than half a decade and certain illegal activities are taking place in the same. It is further submitted that on account of dispute between the Mewat Development Agency and the Director of Secondary Education Haryana, the said building has not been put to good use. It is stated that the petitioner would not press the prayer for the said building to

be given to the petitioner and would only press the prayer for the said building to be put to good use by the authorities and for the said purpose, he seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file appropriate proceedings/petition, in accordance with law.

3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

4. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the maintainability or otherwise of the proceedings / petition which the petitioner proposes to file.
