HARPREET KAUR JEEWAN, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.144 dated 10.06.2022, under Sections 323, 377, 406, 498-A, 506 IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Sector-9, Ambala City (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise deed dated 05.03.2024 (Annexure P-2), executed between the parties.
2. This Court, vide order dated 18.03.2024, had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.
3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, the parties have appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ambala and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, the learned Magistrate has submitted report dated 25.04.2024 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the



statement of the Investigating Officer - HC Satbir Singh, the FIR was registered against total 06 accused persons. However, during investigation, 03 persons have been declared as innocent. The petitioners have not been declared as “Proclaimed Offender” and they are not involved in any other criminal case.

4. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant F.I.R.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in “Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007” (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052 and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in “Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others” (2012) 10 SCC 303, this petition is allowed and FIR No.144 dated 10.06.2022, under Sections 323, 377, 406, 498-A, 506 IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Sector-9, Ambala City (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are ordered to be quashed qua the petitioners.

7. However, the respondent No.2 and the State shall be at liberty to seek cancellation of this order, in case the final terms and conditions of compromise deed dated 05.03.2024 (Annexure P-2) are violated.

8. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
