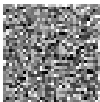

1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ of certiorari, quashing the order dated 27.03.2001 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.2, whereby respondent Nos.4 to 8, junior to him have been promoted from the post of Fitter to that of Sectional Officer in the pay scale of Rs.5800-9200 w.e.f. 27.03.2001, with all the consequential benefits along with 18 % interest.

2. As per office report, notices issued to respondent Nos.4 to 6 have been received back unserved for want of correct address. Notice issued to respondent No.7 has been received back with the report that he has retired from service.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Jaswinder Singh, Sr. Assistant, department of Local Govt of Punjab, submits that the petitioner has already retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 28.02.2010 and unfortunately, he died on 12.08.2018. However, his LRs have
