1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for assailing/setting aside of summons dated 08.11.2023 bearing No.265-5P and summons dated 20.11.2023 bearing No.269-5P from Police Station NRI, Amritsar, Punjab issued to the petitioners by the office of the Officer Incharge of the Police Station NRI, Amritsar, Punjab (Annexures P-1 & P-2).

2. Learned State counsel has filed a short reply dated 27.05.2024 by way of an affidavit of Jagjit Singh, PPS, Assistant Inspector General of Police, NRI Wing, Amritsar on behalf of respondent Ns.1 to 3-State, which is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners.

3. Learned State counsel submits that nothing survives in the present petition as FIR No.16 dated 04.04.2024 under Sections 406, 498-A, 354-A, 506 IPC at Police Station NRI, Amritsar has been registered against the petitioners.

4. In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition and he seeks liberty to file a fresh petition by challenging the FIR (supra).
5. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
