By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.16 dated 11.02.2024 registered under Sections 307, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur.

A perusal of the FIR would reveal that the petitioner is specifically attributed to be armed with datar and he had given datar blow to Ravinder Singh.
