Learned counsel for respondent No.1 has stated that she has sought instructions from respondent No.1, pursuant to the order of the preceding date and respondent No.1, is ready to settle the case as offered by the petitioner on the last date of hearing for total amount of Rs.80,000/- payable by the petitioner to respondent No.1 in four monthly installments of Rs.20,000/- each.

Pursuant to the order of the preceding date, the petitioner has brought demand draft for Rs.20,000/- in favour of respondent No.1. Photocopy of the demand draft has been retained on the file and the original demand draft has been given to the counsel for respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for respondent No.1 has given the particulars of the bank account of respondent No.1 by way of photocopy of cheque and copy thereof has been placed on the file. The petitioner, who undertakes to deposit the remaining 3 monthly installments of Rs.20,000/- each in the said bank account of respondent No.1 on or before 03.06.2024, 03.07.2024 and 03.08.2024. On such payment, the Criminal Revision Petition shall be deemed to have been allowed and the impugned orders of both the Courts below shall stand set aside and the petitioner shall stand acquitted in the case. However, if the petitioner commits default in payment of any installment as aforesaid, respondent No.1 shall be at

him shall stand forfeited.

The Criminal Revision Petition is disposed of accordingly.
