This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing respondent no.5 to decide the partition proceedings/ Taksim dated 26.03.2021 (Annexure P-1) pending before respondent no.5 as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a specified time frame.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that in the present case, several respondents have already filed reply and one respondent is yet to file reply and other respondents have been proceeded against ex-parte. It is submitted that Naksha "A" has already been prepared and reference has been made to zimni orders dated 18.05.2022 and 17.01.2022 to show that the Presiding Officer was on leave and thus, the matter was adjourned and the case was last adjourned on 18.05.2022 to

Learned State counsel has submitted that every endeavour would be made by respondent no.5 to decide the case as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 9 months from the date of the receipt of certified copy of the present order.

Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.5 to decide the partition case filed by the petitioner as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of 9 months from the date of the receipt of certified copy of the present order.
