This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 15.12.2023 passed in CWP-28336-2023.

Compliance affidavit of Sh. N.K. Jain, Director, Local Audit Haryana, Panchkula on behalf of respondent No.2 has been filed today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the petitioner has since been transferred to Rohtak as per her option. Copy of transfer order has also been annexed with the aforesaid compliance affidavit.
