RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for non-compliance of the order dated 16.01.2024 passed in CWP-903-2024.

2. Short reply on behalf of respondent No.2 filed in the Registry is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 16.01.2024 passed in CWP-903-2024 has been complied with and necessary order dated 13.05.2024 has been passed. He has handed over an amount of Rs.25,000/- towards costs to learned counsel for the petitioner today in the Court; because the order has not been passed within the stipulated period as per the order of the Writ Court.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.



5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
