Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is for issuance of directions to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, to decide the representation dated 23.02.2024 (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner and to register the FIR under the relevant provisions of the Indian Penal Code. Further, directions may be issued to respondent No. 2 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in the matter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, he would be satisfied if direction is issued to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, to consider and take a final decision representation dated 23.02.2024 (Annexure P-1) made by the petitioner, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. C.S. Bakshi, Addl. P.P. for U.T. Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of respondents and submits that he has no objection in

case the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner at this stage, is accepted.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without going into the merits of the present petition, the same is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, to forthwith consider the grievance(s) raised by the petitioner in the aforesaid representation and take action thereupon as he deems fit, in accordance with law, within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
