1. Present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members and further prayer is for directing the respondent Nos.2 and 3 for taking strict legal action against the private respondents and for conducting fair investigation and making arrest of private respondents in case FIR No.002 dated 13.01.2021 under Sections 341, 323, 506, 354, 149 of IPC at Police Station Sangat, Bathinda, District Bathinda and for issuing directions to take strict legal action upon representation dated 25.01.2021 (Annexure P-3).

2. Reply dated 20.02.2023 by way of an affidavit of Narinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Rural), Bathinda on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3-State has been filed and the same is taken on record.

3. Learned State counsel, at the very outset, submits that the grievance raised by the petitioner, in the present petition, has been substantially redressed as his representation (Annexure P-3) has already been decided. Further, the investigating agency has already concluded the investigation and presented the final report before the jurisdictional Court under Section 173 Cr.P.C. and the charges have already been framed. Now, the case is fixed for prosecution evidence.
4. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is satisfied with the action taken by the jurisdictional police authorities and submits that he has no objection, in case, the present petition is disposed of in terms of the stand taken by learned State counsel.
5. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, present petition is disposed of as no further directions are required to be passed.
