1. The petitioners are seeking the concession of bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in Complaint No. COMA/46361/2023 dated 08.06.2023/01.07.2023 filed under Section 132 of the CGST Act, 2017 before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana.

2. On 19.03.2024, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had noticed the following submissions made by learned senior counsel for the petitioners:

“Senior counsel for the petitioners relies upon order dated 04.03.2024 passed in CRM-M-10468-2024, whereby main accused Sanjiv Goyal has been granted interim protection. Further submits that the petitioners in the



present petition are merely employees of the firm and the main allegations, if any, will be against Sanjiv Goyal.”

3. Vide order dated 08.04.2024, the petitioners had been granted one weeks’ time to appear before the learned trial Court with a direction that they shall be released subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

4. Learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 08.04.2024, the petitioners had appeared before the learned trial Court and have since been released on bail by the Court concerned.

5. Learned Sr. Standing Counsel CBIC as well as learned State counsel, on instructions, do not dispute the submissions made by the learned senior counsel for the petitioners.

6. In the circumstances, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 08.04.2024 is made absolute.
