JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent No.3 to decide Statutory Appeal dated 03.06.2023 (Annexure P-4).

2. The petitioner was dismissed from service and on the intervention of this Court was reinstated. He was subjected to punishment of stoppage of five increment with cumulative effect. The Appellate Authority reduced the said punishment to one increment with cumulative effect for a period of one year. The respondent vide communication dated 16.11.2022 (Annexure P-3) fixed his pay. He has filed Statutory Appeal against order dated 16.11.2022 before the Appellate Authority which is still pending.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.3 may be directed to decide his Statutory Appeal dated 03.06.2023

(Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner.

4. Notice of motion.
5. Mr. N.K. Vashisht, Senior Panel Counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-UOI and waives service.
6. With the consent of both sides, the matter is taken up for final disposal.
7. The Appellate Authority-Inspector General of Police CRPF, Hallomajra, Chandigarh is hereby directed to decide Appeal of the petitioner within 12 weeks from today.
