1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order/letter dated 23.12.2023 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.3 whereby the application dated 05.12.2023 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner for leave to start the internship of the petitioner has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the impugned order/letter dated 23.12.2023 (Annexure P-5), reliance has been placed upon para No.6(a) of the minutes of meeting of Department of Social Justice, Empowerment and Minorities memo no.17/22598-607 dated 30.07.2018. It is further submitted that in spite of the representation having been sent by the petitioner via an email dated 01.02.2024 (Annexure P-13) asking for supply of the above-said minutes of meeting,

the same have not been supplied till date. It is submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied, at this stage, in case, respondent No.3 is directed to consider the said representation dated 01.02.2024 (Annexure P-13) and to supply a copy of para No.6(a) of the minutes of meeting of Department of Social Justice, Empowerment and Minorities memo no.17/22598-607 dated 30.07.2018, in a time bound manner and has prayed that liberty be granted to the petitioner to challenge the impugned action after challenging/annexing the said minutes of meeting.

3. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to supply a copy of para No.6(a) of the minutes of meeting of Department of Social Justice, Empowerment and Minorities memo no.17/22598-607 dated 30.07.2018, within a period of 10 days from today, in case, the petitioner approaches the office of respondent No.3. It would be open to the petitioner to file a fresh petition on the present cause of action after challenging/annexing the said memo dated 30.07.2018.
