The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.18, dated 20.01.2024, under Sections 379-B, 34 and 506 of IPC, 1860 and Section 25(1-B) (a) of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station 13-17, Panipat, District Panipat.

This Court vide order dated 21.03.2024, while issuing notice of motion, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 21.03.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Jawahar Lal, CIA-2, Panipat, does not controvert the said fact and further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, the order dated 21.03.2024 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed off.
