1. Petition herein is, inter alia, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the Notification dated 27.02.2024 (Annexure P-8), issued by respondent No. 1 and order dated 28.02.2024 (Annexure P-9), passed by respondent No. 2, qua the petitioner, whereby the Gram Panchayats, which have completed the term of five years, have been dissolved from the date of their first meeting in terms of Article 243-E of Constitution of India and Section 15 of Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 and Administrators have been appointed for the Gram Panchayats.

Further direction has been sought from the respondents to allow the petitioner to continue her work on the post of Sarpanch of Gram Panchayat of village Bhamme Kalan, District Mansa.

2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner is hereby directed to make a fresh representation before respondent No. 2 within a period of one week.

4. On filing of such representation, respondent No. 2 shall consider the same and pass a reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of such representation.

5. With the aforesaid observations and direction, the instant civil writ petition is disposed of.

6. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
